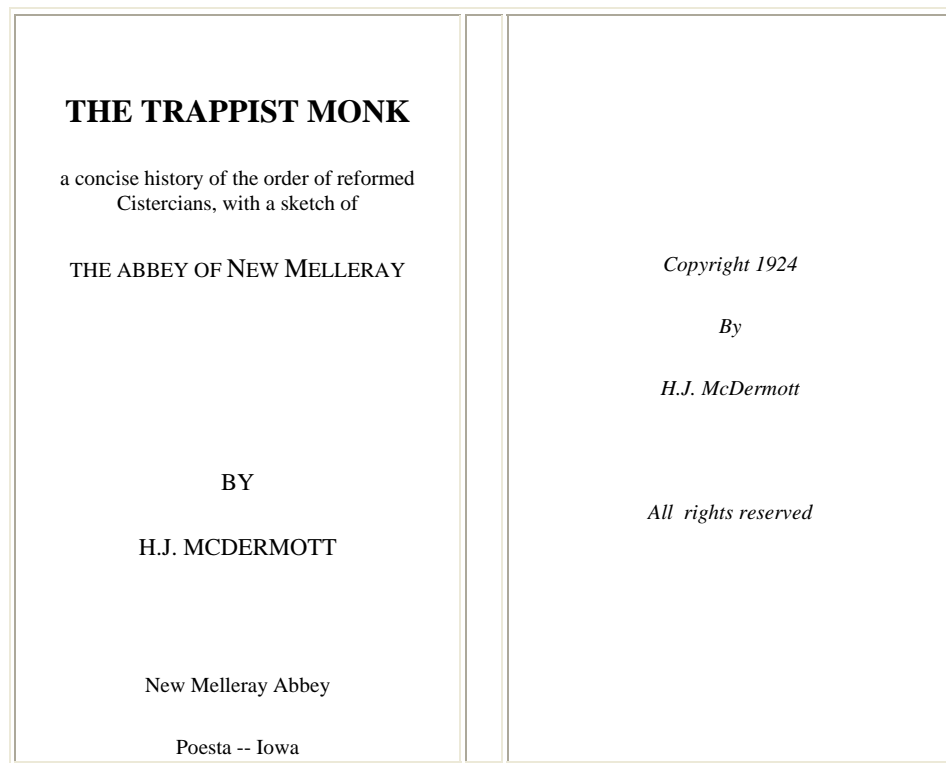
Purpose: To afford practice with AACR2 description.

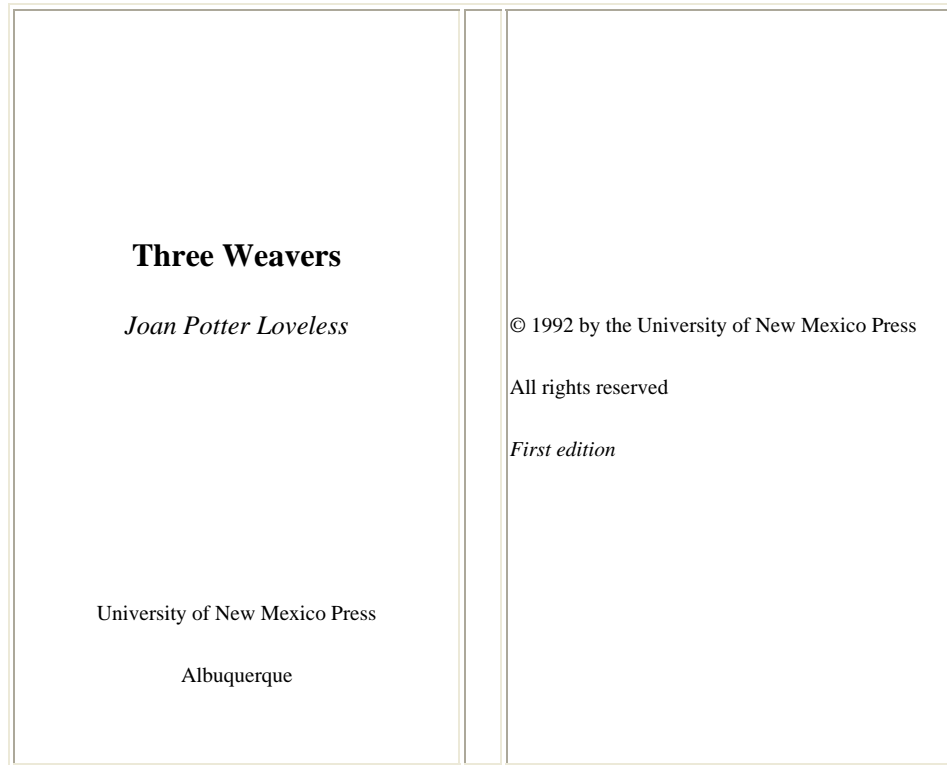


The book has 113 pages and has 11 black and white illustrations, some of which are portraits. The spine measures 19.4 cm; the width of the book is 5.25 cm.

ix, 217 p. : ill. (some col.) ; 24 cm.

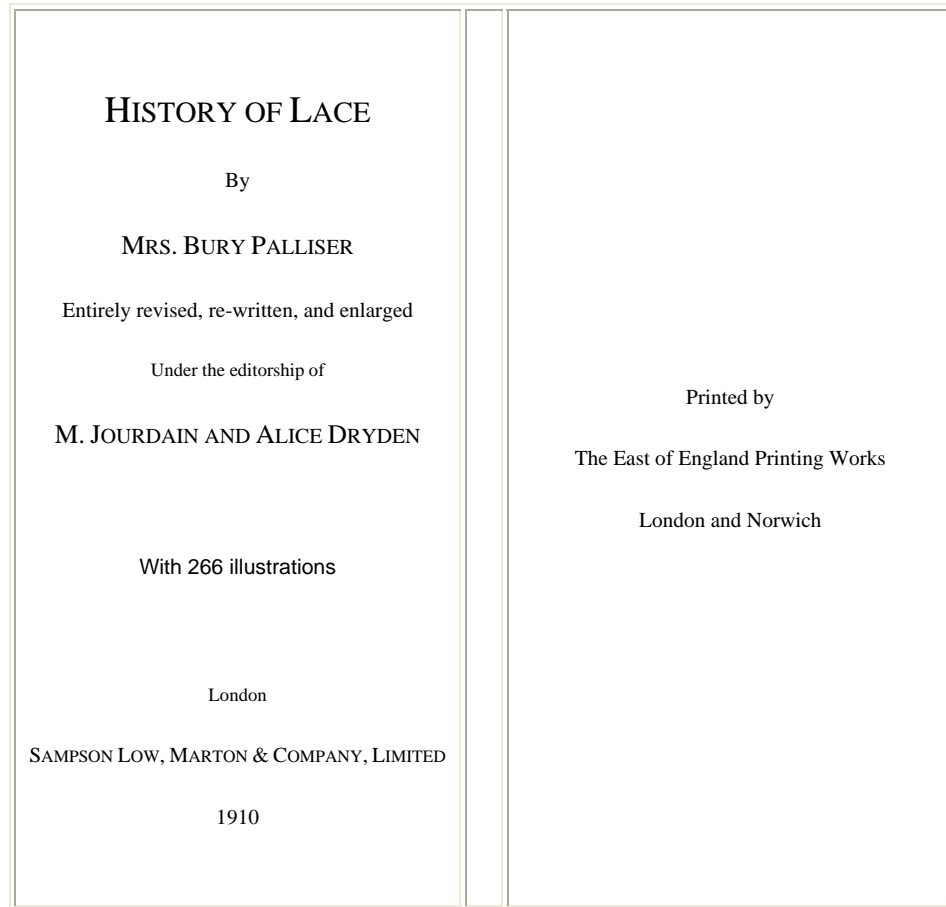


The book has sections numbered to ix and 217. There are illustrations, 25% of which are in color. The spine measures 23.5 cm.

The book has sections numbered to xvi and 536. There are plates numbered to XCIII and “figures” (which look surprisingly like illustrations) numbered to 173. Both plates and figures are black and white. The spine measures 25.4 cm. Introductory material indicates that this is the 4th edition.
